Entrance of the Public and Accreditations


 Public admission is completely free throughout the day of the race


 Club accreditation and weigh-ins

- The accreditation of the clubs will be made in the entrance hall of the pavilion during the following period:


- April 25 between 08:00 and 13:00



 All athletes and coaches will receive a credential for access to the competition and warm-up area

 The weighings will be carried out in a room to be indicated by the Staff during two periods:

- April 25 between 09:00 am and 12:30 pm, and between 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm

 The call of the athletes will be made in the **Warm-Up Room**, up to one hour before the **scheduled time of the race**

Note: All athletes must weigh in up to one hour before their race;

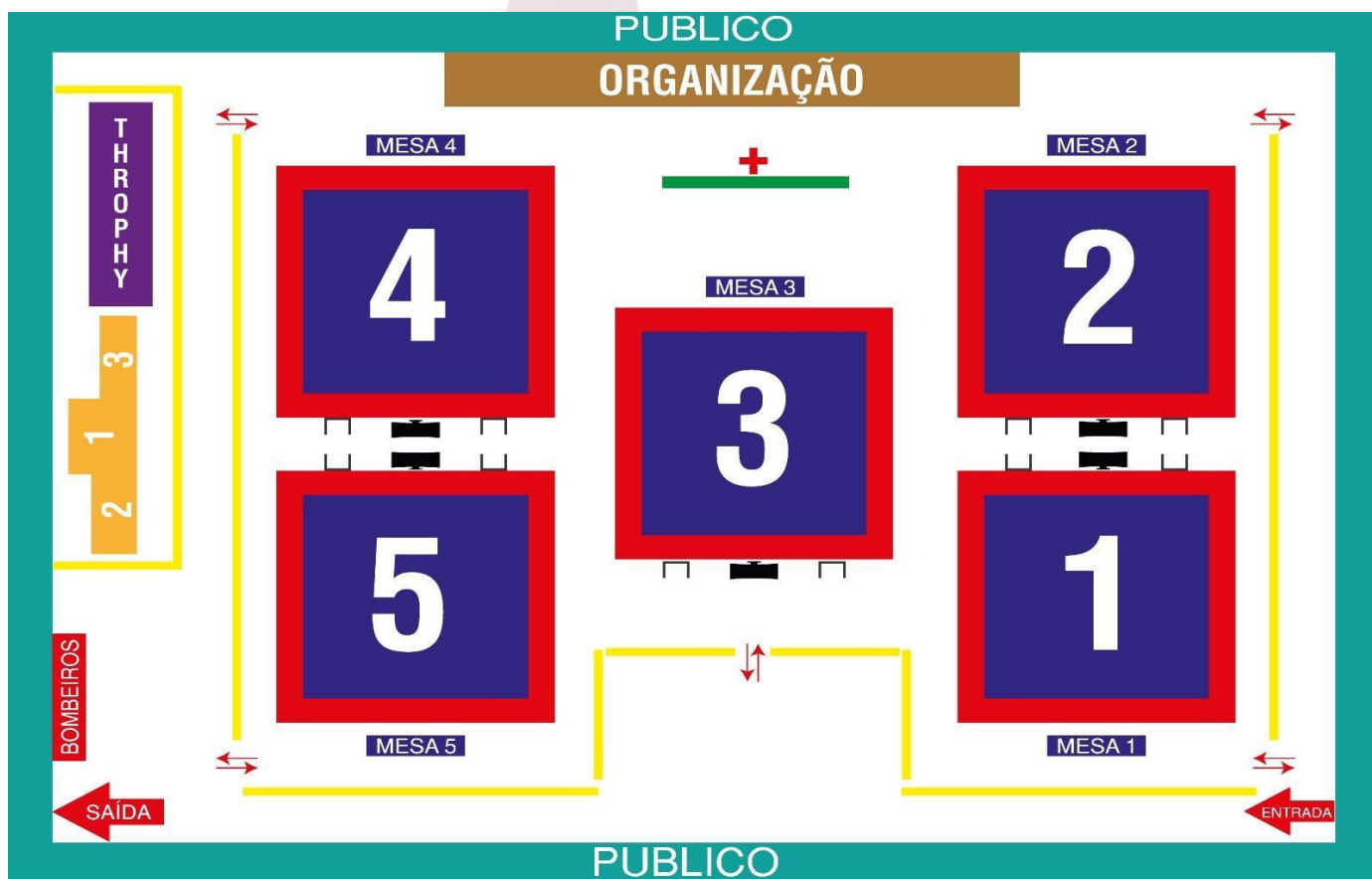

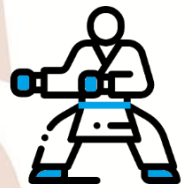

Competition Rules

-  The arbitration rules will be those in force at FNK-P/WKF, however the organization safeguards the possibility of making changes it deems necessary. If they exist, they will be mentioned at the meeting of referees and coaches
-  The duration of each fight will be 2 minutes, except for the Initiates level, which will be 1 minute according to FNKP rules;
The (expected) duration of the Senior class fights will be 3 minutes
-  Complaints will not be accepted for alleged errors of technical valuation
-  The organization is not responsible for any accidents and their consequences that may take place in this competition. Thus, athletes will have to be covered by sports insurance as well as compliance with the DGS indications for participation in the event
-  The Organization will provide the necessary medical support throughout the course of the race
-  Only accredited Coaches will have access to the spaces reserved for the competition and warm-up area
-  The presentation of a valid identification document (CC) will be mandatory
-  The margin of weight failure will be as provided for in the rules and regulations of the FNKP;
In case the athlete does not meet the weight of the category in which he is registered, he will be eliminated from the race

NOTE: The organization safeguards the possibility of changing any of this information. If this happens, the changes will be mentioned at the coaches' meeting
